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

The UKH Expo 2023 is sponsored by Hawax Corporation and 4 Bridges Company.



Documentary Filmmaker

"My only wish is to see him once again, that's all." This is what Amsha, the protagonist of the BBC documentary film, told me, before she burst into tears.

It was one of the most unforgettable moments in my career, for the bond I created with Amsha when making the documentary.

It was within the walls of University of Kurdistan Hawler that I started my first steps as a 17 years old freshman majoring in Politics and International Relation, an academic pursuit that set the stage for my career.

For me, UKH was a vibrant community that embraced students from all corners of Kurdistan, and Iraq. It was a shared journey of knowledge, lots and lots and lots of research papers, and lifetime friendships. Together we intertwined our lives through the tapestry of challenges, triumphs, tears and laughter. I forever cherish the moments we experienced as a community.

After my graduation in 2018, I carved a path in the field of journalism and filmmaking, to shed the light on the untold stories in my Kurdish community and amplify the voices of the marginalized.

I started working in a production company producing a local documentary series named Deng telling society related stories through beautiful short films, but that all ended during the pandemic.

After that, I decided to live paycheck to paycheck and be a full time freelancer because I wanted to take these local stories to the international community, and so I did. For almost two years, together with a work partner we traveled around Kurdistan, spoke to people, and dug

for unique stories. The journey took me to remarkable places allowing me to collaborate with BBC and VICE News. I have been privileged to create impactful international films that delved into pressing social issues. From shedding the light on faith healer scammers in Kurdistan to abusing dogs for dogfighting for VICE news.

The closest to my heart is the story of the young Yazidi girl Amsha who is



healing from the trauma of her captivity through cleaning her homeland, Sinjar, from the mines planted by ISIS, but still waiting for her missing brother who was also held captive. The film was published by BBC our world in 2021.

These films were not made without challenges apart from the technical, logistical challenges, and the potential cost of freedom of expression in this country. "Every Kurdish girl has her own battle to fight behind the walls, before even stepping out of the house" this is a quote from my speech in the prestigious Rory Peck Awards where I was nominated for a journalism award in November 2021 in London. It was an unforgettable moment and an honor to be internationally recognized.

Looking ahead, my journey continues to unfold as long as I am driven by my passion and purpose. I continue to push boundaries, break barriers, and paint vibrant narratives that have the potential to improve my community. As I reminisce on the path, I am grateful for every detail, but UKH remains the foundation that helped me build up on.

RAMYAR JAMAL Assistant Lecturer at Catholic University in Erbil



In 2011, I joined UKH and embarked on a two-year access program before choosing to major in International Relations. During my second year in the access program, I took on the role of an extra classes teacher, where I taught English language and its skills to first-level students. Throughout my five years at UKH, I remained an active and engaged student. In 2014, I co-founded the Politics Society Club, organizing various events, inviting politicians, and hosting exhibitions. That same year, I received the Dean's Honor Roll recognition for being a top student.

My dedication and involvement led to a remarkable opportunity in 2015. Recognized as a top and active student, I was selected as one of the three participants in a funded exchange program to study at the University of Sciences Po in Reims, France. In 2019, I returned to Iraq and joined the American University in Iraq-Sulemaniya's Gender Center, collaborating with UKRI and LSE. My work there involved collecting, parting knowledge to students. analyzing, translating, and transcribing

data on masculinities, gender studies, and gender-based violence (GBV). I conducted interviews, literature reviews, pop culture analyses, and reviewed proverbs and political party bylaws, delving into extensive research.

After three years at AUIS, I transitioned to Knowledge University, initially as an assistant lecturer in the International Relations department. Within six months, I was promoted to the position of Head of Academic Unit in the Quality Assurance Directorate. During my tenure at Knowledge University, I achieved several milestones, including publishing a scientific paper, presenting at an international conference, teaching various modules, supervising thesis projects, and organizing a language course for 100 religious leaders. In recognition of my volunteer work for running the course, I received an award from the KRG Minister of Religious Affairs.

Currently, I am working as an assistant lecturer in the International Relations department at Catholic University in Erbil, continuing my journey in academia and im-


